SOUTH ATLANTIC REGIONS PRESIDENTS MEETING ~ October 3, 2025

- ▲ There are **18,037 Members** in the South Atlantic Region and **151 Chapters**
- ▲ **Collegiate Chapters - Project HERS** November 21st – 23rd. Hosted by, Eta Tau Chapter of Virginia Commonwealth University, Richmond, Virginia. **Omicron Phi Chapter** at **Clemson** University has asked GSCAC to support two of their chapter members to attend. Costs include Registration: \$67.47 per person and Hotel: \$150.00-\$200.00 per night for two nights. **Donations can be made** via cash, checks (payable to Omicron Phi Chapter - DST), or PayPal (<https://www.paypal.biz/ophi22>). **No amount is too small.**
- ▲ As we enter event season, Soror B. Lisa Downney-Hood with the National Scholarship & Standards committee reviewed the Alcohol and Drug Policy; there should be no less than a 45-day notice to acquire insurance and contact our Regional Director Pamela Murphy Lewis on our interest to serve alcohol at an event.
- ▲ 2026 budgets must be voted on during the November chapter meeting. Committee Chairs you should have received an email from our Treasurer asking for your 2026 budgets. The requests should be new with no carry over money from the previous year.

- ▲ Scholarships – Children of Chapter Members – scholarship money given from the chapter must be allocated from each chapter member’s dues. Outside funds or sponsorships cannot be awarded to chapter members children.
- ▲ Scholarships – Children of Chapter Members – scholarship money given from the chapter must be allocated from each chapter member’s dues. Outside funds or sponsorships cannot be awarded to chapter members children.
- ▲ Policy and Procedure documents can allow for other merchant accounts other than PayPal including Square. The chapter’s P&P must have language that refers to using merchant accounts other than PayPal.
- ▲ Sorors must be financial January 1.2026 to continue serving as officers, committee chairs or on committees. Sorors must also be financial January 1.2026 to vote within the chapter. A \$10.00 late fee will be assessed on October 16th, a \$15.00 reinstatement fee will be added after January 1.2026 and if a soror has not been financial for more than two years an additional \$30.00 fee is added.
- ▲ **Delta’s Internal Development** Training should be scheduled 6 weeks in advance for in person trainings and 4 weeks in advance for virtual trainings. Chapters are responsible for the cost of the trainer’s travel, meals and hotel accommodations.
- ▲ The November 1st South Atlantic Region Leadership Training is requesting monetary donations and gently used women and men professional attire for the Aggie Source a professional closet and food pantry for North Carolina A&T Students. Because the meeting is in Greensboro the Region is in the process of identifying a community project on behalf of Bennett College.
